Options for tours, excursions and activities are nigh on limitless and, for those not content with sybaritic relaxation in the privacy of their private villa estate, The Kudat Riviera is an ideal base from which to explore Malaysian Borneo.

The Kudat Riviera will feature signature restaurants including *Rustique* - an informal yet chic beach club restaurant; the *Caviar Sky Lounge*, at 900 feet overlooking the ocean and affording spectacular 360-degree views out to the highest tip of Borneo - Mt. Kinabalu, the northernmost tip of Borneo - Simpang Mengayau and, looking upwards, the deep-sky telescope opens up the awe-inspiring star-filled universe. In addition, a wide range of facilities and services including watersports, in-villa spa treatments, a kids' club, luxury yacht charter, scuba diving, helicopter tours, nearby 18-hole golf course, and excursions to explore the diversity of Borneo.

The Kudat Riviera features expansive luxury villa estates, each occupying between 1-8 acres of private grounds, and spread over 70 acres of stunning coastline. Each individual property revels in its own expansive, manicured private gardens, with gigantic private infinity swimming pool offering a level of space, privacy and seclusion that is almost unprecedented for a luxury villa resort: an average of 2-3 acres per villa.

Protecting the environment is foremost in the minds of EBV, and as such every possible effort has been made to create the greenest and most environmentally-conscious villa resort including movement towards the extensive utilisation of renewable energy sources with solar panels and wind turbines wherever possible, responsible waste management, recycling and use of bio-degradable materials wherever possible.

Each villa is constructed of natural materials throughout, including forest managed timbers, rich coconut tree columns, Alang Alang grass thatch roofing, water hyacinth river-grass woven furniture and natural stone and is centred around a capacious natural stone infinity swimming pool. Three villa designs range from huge 6000sqft "Coco Villas" where the swimming pool actually enters the house, to the mid size "Pandanas Villa" and smaller traditional "Rice Barn Villa".









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All villas at The Kudat Riviera are provided with their own dedicated private butler, always on hand to

provide as much - or as little - assistance as is needed to ensure an effortless and perfect holiday.

Guests may also call upon a private chef to provide truly unique dining in the privacy of their

residence, or to create bespoke culinary experiences in extraordinary settings throughout the Kudat

Riviera.

Malaysian Borneo is centrally located in the heart of South East Asia, and is easily accessible with

multiple daily flights from gateway cities Kuala Lumpur, Singapore, Hong Kong, Macau, Bangkok, and

Brunei to the capital, Kota Kinabalu. Onward transfers from Kota Kinabalu to The Kudat Riviera take

just 40 minutes by private helicopter or twin otter scheduled flight, a pleasant 2.5 hour drive through

rice pady fields and quaint villages, or aboard a luxury yacht.

Malaysian Borneo is truly a land of diversity, not just with its wondrous natural beauty, but with its

warm hospitable multi-ethnic peoples, comprising over 34 ethnic groups and cultures. Guests of the

Kudat Riviera will be swept away by the colours and flavours of the Rungus ethnic tribe that have

populated the northern region for centuries. EBV is committed to preserving the cultural heritage of

the Rungus community, and actively engages in a host of local employment and betterment

programmes which aims to have a positive impact on local community welfare, as well as supporting

ecological and conservation projects in the region.
